Injury to A Western Employee from A Non-Human Primate/B Virus Exposure **After Hours Care**

Attention: University Hospital Emergency Department:

- Western employee, graduate student/post doc has had a potential exposure to B Virus from a non-human primate from one of the animal areas at Western.
- Western employee, graduate student or post doc will provide a detailed history of the incident
- Please draw a blood sample in a 10ml GOLD top tube within the first 2 hours of the incident
- The Western employee MUST take the blood sample with them so that it can be shipped with the non-human primate samples for B-virus testing
- Please provide the employee with a prescription of Valacyclovir (1000mg TID x 14 days) if there is a concern of exposure to B-virus. Please direct the Western employee, graduate student or post doc to Shoppers Drug Mart at 1118 Adelaide St. (phone # 519-432-1809, fax # 519-645-8816)
- Western employee, graduate student or post doc is responsible for following-up in Workplace Health the next business day
